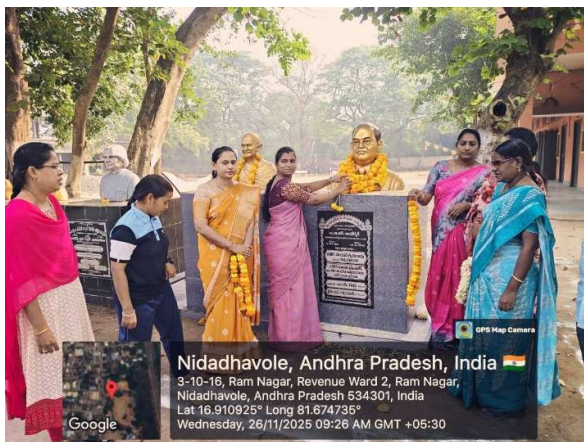






## Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Death Anniversary

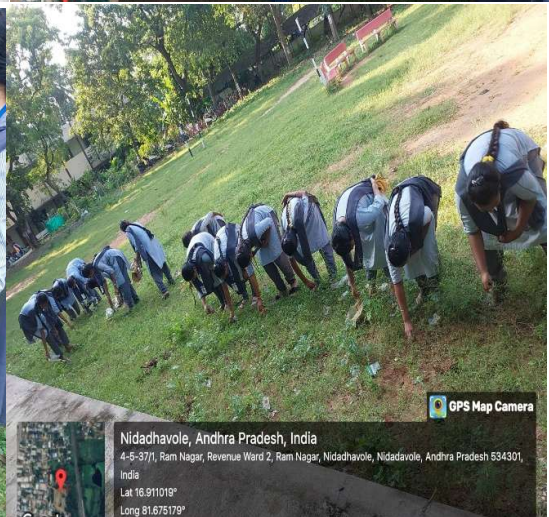
# INTERNATIONAL HUMAN RIGHTS DAY

## Industrial Visit and Internship Observation

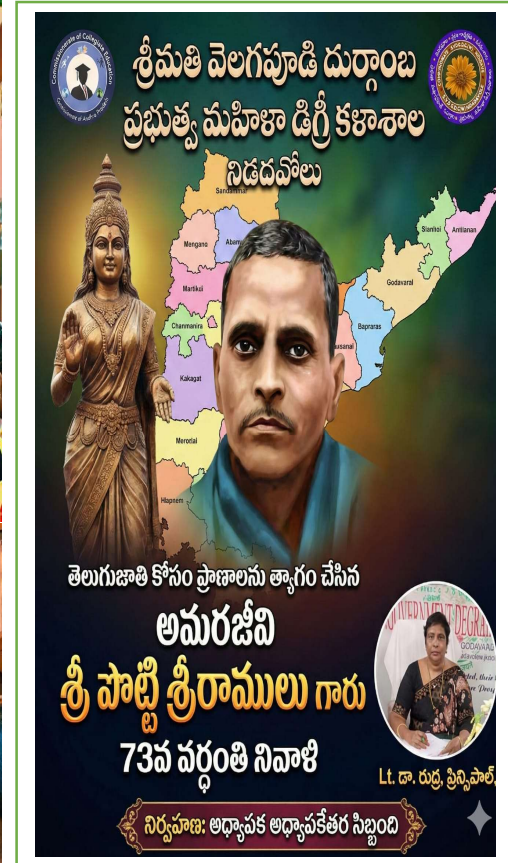

## NATIONAL CONSUMERS DAY


