# SVD GOVERNMENT DEGREE COLLEGE(W) NIDADAVOLE STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2023-24

### FINDINGS FROM THE REPORT

#### **Abstract**

The "Student Satisfaction Survey" document presents a structured evaluation of teaching effectiveness and student engagement at an educational institution, highlighting key areas such as syllabus coverage, teacher preparation, communication proficiency, and support for student development. The survey results reflect students' overall satisfaction with their learning experience, particularly emphasizing the importance of teacher involvement in both academic growth and personal development.

#### **Key Points**

- The survey assesses how much of the syllabus was covered in class, with 86.3% stating 85-100% was covered.
- A majority of 57.5% reported teachers prepared for classes "thoroughly," while 34.2% indicated "satisfactorily."
- Communication between teachers and students is perceived as effective, with 83.6% rating it as "always effective."
- Most students (61.6%) described the teaching approach as "good" or better, reflecting a positive teaching style.
- The fairness of internal evaluations is recognized, as 15.1% of students believe evaluations are "always fair."
- A significant 87.7% confirmed their performance in assignments is discussed with them regularly.
- The institution actively promotes opportunities for internships and visits, with 24.7% stating this occurs regularly.
- The survey shows that 42.5% of respondents "strongly agree" that the institution provides multiple learning opportunities.

- Teachers effectively identify student strengths (67.1% affirmed they do), promoting adequate challenges in learning.
- Overall, 76.7% of respondents rated the quality of the teaching-learning process as.

- There are multiple opportunities provided by the institution for learning and individual growth.
- Students receive clear information about expected competencies and course outcomes.
- Mentoring is deemed effective, with regular follow-ups on assigned tasks reported by most students.
- Teachers use various examples and applications to illustrate concepts effectively.
- Teachers also identify strengths and weaknesses in student performance, aiding in their development.
- The institution involves students in monitoring and improving the teaching process.
- Student-centric methods such as experiential learning are utilized by teachers.
- Participation in extracurricular activities is encouraged by teachers.
- Skills development such as soft and life skills is highlighted as a priority.
- A significant use of ICT tools in teaching methods is reported.
- Overall satisfaction with the quality of the teaching-learning process in the institution is notably
